<u>Agenda item 7: Exchange of views on a political declaration to be adopted at the Third Review Conference</u>

We consider that the political Declaration should remain as short and focused a document as possible.

While agreeing that the high ambitions of the Convention and the previous Action Plans should be maintained, we think that future commitments should be based on a realistic assessment of what can actually be achieved and fully implemented in the foreseeable future, to help ensure that the Convention remains a success story.

Finally, Mr. President-Designate, we would like to thank you once again for your proposals and remain ready to further contribute in the period leading up to the Third Review Conference in Maputo.
